- New mural

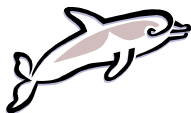
The perimeter drain installation will reduce the mud in the grass along the concrete. This is the final year

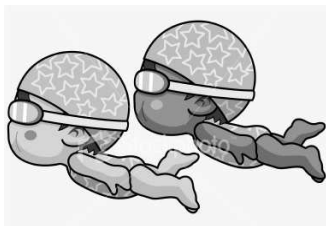


Pre-Season Schedule (during school calendar)
